

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
Per Tier Grade Level **9-12**

HIGH SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 9 - 12

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grades 9 through 12 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) * OR history of having had the disease
6. **One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**) *
7. **One** dose of meningitis vaccine (**Menactra or MCV4**) *
(* indicates new vaccine requirements last school year)

Note: Students involved with Extracurricular Clubs and Organizations and/or who choose to drive to school must be current on all state required immunizations prior to eligibility for participation.

If your student needs any or all of the above vaccines, please make an appointment as soon as possible with your family physician or with the Hancock County Health Department (477-1125).

Once your student has received any new vaccines, the school needs to have the medical documentation, no later than the start of the 2011-2012 school year. You may mail or bring it to the School Administration Office this summer; the address is 110 W. North St., Greenfield, Indiana 46140.

Per Tier Grade Level **7-8**

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 7 - 8

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grades 7 through 8 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) *OR history of having had the disease
6. **One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**) *
7. **One** dose of meningitis vaccine (**Menactra or MCV4**) *
(* indicates new vaccine requirements last school year)

Note: Students involved with Extracurricular Clubs and Organizations must be current on all state required immunizations prior to eligibility for participation.

Per Tier Grade Level **4-6**

INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 6

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grade 6 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) * OR history of having had the disease
6. **One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**) *
7. **One** dose of meningitis vaccine (**Menactra or MCV4**) *
(* indicates new vaccine requirements last school year)

Note: Many students new to 6th grade have not yet received these shots.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 4 - 5

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grades 4 through 5 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **One** dose of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) OR history of having had the disease

If your student needs any or all of the above vaccines, please make an appointment as soon as possible with your family physician or with the Hancock County Health Department (477-1125).

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 2 - 3

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grades 2 through 3 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **One** dose of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) OR history of having had the disease

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES K – 1

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in grades K through 1 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) * OR history of having had the disease
(* notes new vaccine requirements last school year)

If your student needs any or all of the above vaccines, please make an appointment as soon as possible with your family physician or with the Hancock County Health Department (477-1125).

Once your student has received any new vaccines, the school needs to have the medical documentation, no later than the start of the 2011-2012 school year. You may mail or bring it to the School Administration Office this summer; the address is 110 W. North St., Greenfield, Indiana 46140.

Students entering Kindergarten have immunization requirements indicated on the “yellow card” (provided at Kindergarten Round-Up); this yellow medical record card is to be completed by the student’s physician and returned to the School Administration Office by August 1.
