

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Per Grade Levels **6-12, 3-5, 1-2**
GREENFIELD-CENTRAL COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 6 - 12

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in Grades 6 through 12 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis (DTaP) vaccine
3. **Four** doses of polio (IPV) vaccine
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella (MMR) vaccine
5. ***Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) OR history of having had the disease
6. ***One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**)
7. ***One** dose of meningitis vaccine (**Menactra or MCV4**) *

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 3 - 5

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in Grades 3 through 5 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B (**Hep B**) vaccine
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis (**DTaP**) vaccine
3. **Four** doses of polio (**IPV**) vaccine
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella (**MMR**) vaccine
5. **One** dose of chickenpox (**Varicella or Varivax**) vaccine OR history of having had the disease

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES K – 1

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in Grades K through 1 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B (**Hep B**) vaccine
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis (**DTaP**) vaccine
3. **Four** doses of polio (**IPV**) vaccine
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella (**MMR**) vaccine
5. ***Two** doses of chickenpox (**Varicella or Varivax**) vaccine OR history of having had the disease

If your student needs any or all of the above vaccines, please make an appointment as soon as possible with your family physician or with the Hancock County Health Department (477-1125).

(* notes new vaccine requirements last school year)

Once your student has received any new vaccines, the school needs to have the medical documentation, no later than the start of the 2011-2012 school year. You may mail or bring it to the School Administration Office this summer; the address is 110 W. North St., Greenfield, Indiana 46140.

Students entering Kindergarten have immunization requirements indicated on the “yellow card” (provided at Kindergarten Round-Up); this yellow medical record card is to be completed by the student’s physician and returned to the School Administration Office by August 1.

HIGH SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 9 - 12

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in Grades 6 through 12 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) * OR history of having had the disease
6. **One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**) *
7. **One** dose of meningitis vaccine (**Menactra or MCV4**) *

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES 7 - 8

For the 2011-2012 school year, students in Grades 6 through 12 will need to have had the following:

1. **Three** doses of hepatitis B vaccine (**Hep B**)
2. **Five** doses of diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis vaccine (**DTaP**)
3. **Four** doses of polio vaccine (**IPV**)
4. **Two** doses of measles, mumps & rubella vaccine (**MMR**)
5. **Two** doses of chickenpox vaccine (**Varicella or Varivax**) * OR history of having had the disease
6. **One** dose of tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (**Tdap or Adacel**) *
