

SUMMER 2017 FREE MEALS PROGRAM

Weekdays this summer any child 18 and under can eat a free breakfast and/or lunch!

Greenfield-Central Schools is pleased to offer a Summer Food Service Program.

During the school year a significant number of children receive free or reduced priced breakfasts and lunches through their school lunch programs. When the school year ends food uncertainty can become a concern. This Summer Food Service Program relieves that concern by making meals available.

Free breakfasts and/or lunches will be made available to all children 18 years of age and under and to persons over 18 years who are enrolled in an approved educational program for the mentally or physically disabled.

Free meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children.

There will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Free meals will be provided at the sites listed below weekdays beginning May 30, 2017 and ending August 1, 2017. We will not be providing meals on July 4th and July 24th thru August 1st at the Boys & Girls Club.
