

WHAT IS DIFFERENT WITH INHALERS THIS YEAR?

The Indiana State Department of Health has informed us that students that use hand held inhalers must use a spacer this year. Whether your student stores their inhaler in the clinic or self-carries, they must have a spacer. This does not apply to students who use Respiclick inhalers.

For an inhaler to be accepted for use in a GC clinic, the following must be met:

- [Asthma Emergency Care Plan](#) must be filled out by a healthcare provider and signed by a parent or guardian.
- [Request to Administer Prescription Medication Form](#) must be filled out by a healthcare provider and signed by a parent or guardian.
- The inhaler must be in the original box with the prescription label attached.
- A spacer or a spacer with a facemask must be sent in with the inhaler (unless the inhaler is Respiclick).
- All items must be sent in a clear plastic box with a closing lid. Please write your student's name on the outside of the box.
